

**CALLED MEETING, MAYOR AND COUNCIL, CITY OF COVINGTON, GEORGIA, COUNCIL ROOM, PUBLIC BY TELECONFERENCE, SEPTEMBER 29, 2020, 5:30 PM.**

Mayor Steve Horton presided with Mayor Pro-Tem Susie Keck, Council members: Kenneth Morgan, Fleeta Baggett, Don T. Floyd, and Hawnethia Williams. City Manager Scott Andrews, Deputy City Clerk Tiffany Johnston, and City Attorney Frank Turner, Jr. present. Council member Anthony Henderson and City Clerk Audra M. Gutierrez were absent.

Mayor Horton gave the invocation.

Mayor Horton led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

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Mr. Jim Gomez was in attendance to speak on behalf of Ice Days, LLC in regards to an ice rink being placed a Legion Field.

1. Motion made by Council member Keck, seconded by Council member Baggett to enter into a contract for an ice rink at Legion Field with Jim Gonzalez/Ice Days LLC in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 + (plus) \$31,000 in electrical infrastructure + (plus) utility usage for one year, with automatic renewal and termination language included and compliance with both the local and the Governor's executive orders (relating to face masks\COVID 19 compliance).

Motion carried unanimously.

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2. Motion made by Council member Morgan, seconded by Council member Williams to accept the proposal from Georgia Water and Environmental in the amount of \$55,405.00 for the replacement of Dried Indian Creek Bridge at SR 81.
