Copies larger than 11 x 17	\$3.00	<u>Plus</u> additional \$25 per hour labor charge after the first fifteen minutes of staff time.
24 x 36	\$10.00	Standard Base Map Prints
24 x 36 (glossy)	\$40.00	Limited Availability
36 x 48	\$15.00	Standard Base Map Prints
36 x 48 (glossy)	\$50.00	Limited availability
60 x 60	\$25.00	Limited availability
60 x 60 (glossy)	\$100.00	Limited availability
Custom Maps (those requiring analysis)	\$50.00	<u>Plus</u> an additional \$25 per hour labor charge after the first two hours of staff time.
Digital Maps (including PDFs)	No charge for the first fifteen minutes of staff time, but cost will be \$25 per hour thereafter.	Any associated fees <u>must</u> be pre-paid if maps are to be sent via email or FTP.
