



CITY OF COVINGTON CODE ENFORCEMENT

STORING & PARKING TRAILERS & RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

Storage and parking of trailers and recreational vehicles shall be in accordance with the following provisions. Recreational vehicles and trailers of all types, including travel, boat, camping and hauling, shall not be parked or stored on any lot occupied by a dwelling or any lot in any residential district except in accordance with all the following requirements:

- 1. Travel trailers, hauling trailers or boat trailers or one recreational vehicle shall be permitted only if parked or stored behind the front yard building line; which is behind the front corner of the home.
- 2. For authorized uses not specifically mentioned, offstreet parking facilities shall be in accordance with a use which the planning and zoning director considers similar in type
- *Recreational unit means a travel trailer, pickup camper, converted bus, tent-trailer, tent, or similar device used for temporary portable housing.
- *Travel trailer means any vehicular or similar portable structure mounted on wheels, designed and intended primarily for short term occupancy, dwelling or sleeping or other purposes such as travel and recreation, and not exceeding thirty-five (35) feet in length.
