# For I-9 documentation – (copies are not accepted per compliance of I-9 requirements) LISTS OF ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS

- All documents containing an expiration date must be unexpired.
- Documents extended by the issuing authority are considered unexpired.
- Employees may present one selection from List A or a combination of one selection from List B and one selection from List C.
- Examples of many of these documents appear in the Handbook for Employers (M-274).
