## COMPLIANCE OPTIONS

- Make vehicle operational with valid tag.
- Place inside garage or behind fence. You must obtain a permit to install a fence (see **City of Covington Ordinance 16.32.220**).
- \***Donate it\***
- \***Sell it\***
- **Return the car to the relative who asked, "Can I leave it at your house for just a minute?"**

*The City of Covington is promoting the cleanup of non-working cars from our neighborhoods. City Ordinance 8.16.010 prohibits the outdoor storage of wrecked, dismantled, inoperative, abandoned or vehicles without a valid license attached. You will have 30 days from when you are formally notified to remove the vehicle from the property.*
